1. Compost – Turn, combine and cover 2 bins for the winter. Leave one open.
2. Cut down vines and plants that are growing on the fences & dispose in leaf bags. (Especially around the water barrels.) (See Kristina.)
3. Clean, dry and store the water barrels and garbage can in the shed. (Use rags provided and dish soap to clean.)
4. Collect trash around garden and Berean property. Including along Girard and 20th Streets outside of the fence.
5. Weed the pathways along the fence.
6. Cut back the tall ornamental grasses on either sides of the parking lot fence.
7. Dig up and dispose of all the sunflower stalks.
8. Collect seed heads, place in paper bags and label for next year's use.
9. Cut back the fennel.
10. Clean out and organize the shed.
11. Take inventory of all tools and supplies belonging to the garden. (Written list including tools, sharpness, usability, quality, current state, etc.)
12. Dig up the tree growing in with the raspberries.
13. Cut back the Butterfly Bush. (See Kristina)
14. Stack the tomato cages or throw out ones in poor condition.
15. Bundle all plant stakes, poles and arbors belonging to the garden in the shed.
16. Collect and take home all personal garden tools, watering cans, stakes, poles, cages etc. Personal items cannot be stored in the shed over the winter.
17. Mow the grass
18. Weed whack – Pick up gas/oil mixture
19. Haul all the leaf bags and trash back to the dumpster.
